ASET NORTH - Mazar e Sharif and beyond

Hospital Clinic

We have begun building a \$60,000 hospital building in the village north of Mazar. The race is on to finish before winter sets in!



Sinking a 100 metre deep well in a dry and parched land.

Currently the villagers have a 12 hour round trip by donkey to get clean water. This well, together with the clinic and school will service approximately 30,000 people in the surrounding villages.

Women's literacy – new program started to teach 120 more women to read and write, taking total to 300.

Kindergarten – Now nearly 100 children and 10 teachers. The Afghan trainee teachers are doing great work under Faith's (Project Manager) expert tuition.

EFL – Levi and Mark back in town – Teaching the ever popular ASET English classes complete with personal tuition!

Teacher Training – continues in the villages and now looking for funds to extend the training to English teachers throughout the Northern region.

Widows Suit Making Program

Helping Afghan women start their own businesses making men's suits

The aim is to train up to 50 women to make men's suits and trousers. Then three women will be trained to own, run and operate two suit/trouser making businesses



We received suit patterns from the west, which were then transferred to the table cloth and used to cut the material for the suits

Fatima became our second trainer and future business owner. She's a 25 year old refugee returnee from Iran.
